**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.**

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No entry fees will be refunded after the close date without a veterinary excuse.
- Entry fees will be refunded up to 75% for withdrawals made prior to the trial close date.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

**\*\*Dog must be registered** and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. On line registration, dog height measurement forms and the current Exhibitors Handbook are available at the NADAC web site: [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com). Exhibitors may request a written copy of the current Exhibitor Handbook by sending \$5.00 to: North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC), P.O. Box 1206, Colbert, OK 74733-1206

**Trial Information:**

The trial is open to dogs, both mixed breed and pure breed, 18 months of age or older. Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as are any dogs with deformity or disability which the judge may deem as unable to perform the obstacles in a safe manner that is in the best interest of the health and welfare of the dog.

A refund of up to 75% will be made if a veterinarian's certificate of proof of injury or illness of the dog or a bitch in heat is submitted to the trial secretary PRIOR TO CHECK-IN on August 28, 2010.

**Move Ups:** There will be no same day move ups. If you title on Saturday, you may move up to the next level provided a move-up form is submitted prior to 6 PM on Saturday. Move up forms will be available at the registration table.

**IMPORTANT.** Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the [NADACagility@yahoo.com](mailto:NADACagility@yahoo.com) list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the [www.NADACagility@yahoo.com](http://www.NADACagility@yahoo.com) list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

**Levels.** Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

**Non-Jumping classes – Veteran Handler:**

Disabled handlers or handlers aged 60 yrs. or older may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. This division is for handlers only. The 10% additional SCT is for qualifying purposes only for those who may need the additional time to negotiation the course due to physical limitations. Veteran Handlers in the non-jumping classes will be scored and placed with their standard division jump height. When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all classes and all dogs in this division for the weekend.

**Proficient/Skilled Categories:** Each class will be split into two categories, proficient and skilled. After January 1 2009, dogs in the skilled category MUST jump 4" lower than their Standard, Proficient jump height (NO dog may jump less than 4"). In the regular agility class, dogs entered in the skilled category may incur 5 or fewer faults, and earn a 5 pt qualifying round. In the proficient category a qualifying round must be clean and will earn 10 pts. There is no 5 pt qualifying round in the proficient category.

## **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies and other vaccinations are current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members) and Quad City Dog Center, L.L.C.(including officers, employees, volunteers and trial committee), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the forementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

### **Club Policies**

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause.

- 1.1 All exhibitors are responsible for the behaviour of their dog(s) and /or children. Any exhibitor and their dogs and/or children who engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case no refunds of entries will be made.
- 1.2 No leads, collars, food, toys, balls clickers or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at anytime.
- 1.3 Dogs must be on leash anywhere on the showgrounds property or in crates, when not competing in the ring. NO dogs may be tied to cars, fences, trees or other obstacles at any time.
- 1.4 Every owner is responsible for clean up of waste from their dogs. Any violator will be asked to leave the trial site without refund of entry fees.
- 1.5 Management reserves the right to retain a 10% service charge for any cancelled entry, regardless of date or reason.

**From the North or Northeast**, take US 61 or I-88 to I-80 West. Follow I-80 West to I-280 East. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn right on West Locust and proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2390 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

**From the East**, take I-80 to I-74 to I-280 West. Follow I-280, crossing the Mississippi River. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street. Turn left on West Locust and proceed one block to West Lake Boulevard. Turn right. Quad City Dog Center is at 2390 West Lake Boulevard, across from Honda plant.

**From the South**, take I-74 West to I-280 West. Follow I-280 west, crossing the Mississippi River. Exit at Iowa Exit 4, West Locust Street.
