

- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.
- MIXED BREED DOGS THAT HAVE BEEN LISTED WITH AKC CANINE PARTNERS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THIS TRIAL PROVIDING THEIR LISTING NUMBER HAS BEEN RECORDED ON THE ENTRY FORM.
- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** (on the date of the show) are not permitted to compete. Refunds less \$5 administrative fee per class entered per day will be made for bitches that come in season after the closing date for the trial. Written Notification to claim refund must be received by the Secretary by Friday, March 20,2025.
- NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made. Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.
- **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

- JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES except when being judged. ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS off leash at any time on Convention Center grounds per AKC and Convention Center rules.
- CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that Show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for Cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.
- ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the show. If not, they become the property of the Show Giving Club. NO TROPHIES will be mailed.
- QUAD CITY DOG OBEDIENCE CLUB AND SCOTT COUNTY KENNEL CLUB RESERVE THE RIGHT to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value.
- ALL VIDEOTAPING during the Show requires Club permission.

Any exhibitor arguing with show officials or exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be subject to Event Committee Jurisdiction.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.

ATTENTION: JUMP HEIGHT REQUIRED ON ENTRY FORM!

Per Chapter 1, Section 3 of the AKC Obedience Regulations amended June 2008 and effective January 1, 2016, entries must include a jump height to be acceptable.

OBEDIENCE entries in the classes that use jumps Open, Utility, Graduate Novice, Graduate Open, Versatility, must include a jump height on the entry form in order to be a valid entry, obedience entries <u>WILL</u> be arranged by jump height (small to tall) at these trials.
