The foundation of her distance is all pressure based and how to apply it for consistency and accuracy. Paula works with each team's strengths and adds step by step instructions on how to improve. She provides the handler with clear, consistent tools for teaching distance and efficient handling.

This seminar is for teams that have some good distance handling skills but want to develop and enhance more advanced and independent skills. Dogs must be able to do all obstacles including 6 weave poles to participate. Expect challenges that will require you to handle your dog 20-30 feet away from you.

SUNDAY MAY 11, 2025, 8:00-1200 8 working slots, audit spots available if working slots are filled.

This seminar is for novice/open teams and will focus on training and enhancing basic distance handling skills. Dogs should be proficient on jumps, tunnels and some contacts and be able to sequence 9 to 14 obstacles. There will **not** be weaves in any sequences.
